Temperatures

Daytime temperatures range between 27°C and 32°C (81°F -90°F), while nights are cooler, around 22°C (72°F).

Rain

Although the rainy season is ending, there may still be occasional light showers, especially at the beginning of the month. However, rainfall will be significantly lower compared to the peak rainy months of September and October.

Humidity

Moderate humidity remains, but it will decrease as the month progresses.

What to Pack:

- Light, breathable clothing for warm days
- A light rain jacket or umbrella, just in case of occasional showers
- Sunscreen, sunglasses, and a hat for the sunny days
